

GROWTH SIMILAR TO YEAR-AGO PERIOD

NPS subscribers increase 23%

Assets under management up by 23.5%

New Delhi, March 10

THE NUMBER OF subscribers under various schemes of the National Pension System (NPS) increased 22.9% to over 62.48 million, while their assets under management (AUM) rose 23.45% to ₹8.82 trillion, as of March 4.

The growth rates both in the number of subscribers and AUM were almost on the same lines as a year ago, despite the higher base.

Of the total subscribers, there was over 28% growth in the Atal Pension Yojana (APY) subscribers, with the addition of more than 10 million new customers during the annual period ending March 4. The APY guarantees a minimum monthly pension of ₹1,000-5,000 to the lower-income group subscribers based on their contributions.

Of the total 62.48 million subscribers currently, 2.39 million and 6.07 million are Central and state government employees, respectively. Corporate subscribers stood at 1.66 million. As of March 5, 2022, the total number of NPS subscribers was 50.85 million. The number of APY subscribers rose 28.4% to 45.3 million as of March 4, 2023. The government introduced APY on June 1, 2015, to provide social security to workers,

mainly in the unorganised sector.

After the Centre rolled out the NPS for its new employees (except the armed forces) and that of Central autonomous bodies from January 1, 2004, almost all states made it mandatory for their employees in 2004-2005. Subsequently, the NPS was extended to all Indian citizens voluntarily from May 2009, and to corporate sector employees in December 2011.

ED searches Lalu's family, RJD leaders

THE ENFORCEMENT DIRECTORATE (ED) on Friday conducted searches in multiple cities of Bihar and other locations, including premises of former chief minister Lalu Prasad Yadav's family and RJD leaders, in connection with a money laundering investigation into the land for jobs scam case.

During the raids, ₹53 lakh, \$1,900, about 540 grams of gold and bullion, and 1.5 kg of gold jewellery were seized, sources in the agency said, adding that one of the locations searched was a house in south Delhi, where Yadav's son and Bihar deputy chief minister Tejashwi Yadav was present. The house in Delhi's New Friends Colony area is the registered address of a "beneficiary company", AK Infosystems, involved in the case but, according to the ED, it was being used as a residential property by the Yadav family. The searches also covered premises linked to Lalu Prasad's daughters Ragini Yada, Chanda Yadav and Hema Yadav, former RJD MLA Syed Abu Dojana, Amit Katal, Navdeep Sardana and Praveen Jain. PTI

Bumper harvest pulls down onion, potato prices, leads to distress sale

Onion inflation in negative zone for long

BUMPER HARVESTS HAVE pulled down prices of key vegetables onion and potato, resulting in a glut that has forced many farmers to resort to distress sale in the key producing states of Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Maharashtra, Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh.


Because of the sharp fall in prices of both the vegetables, farmers are unable to recover the cost of production, an official said.

The average mandi prices of onion at Lasalgaon, the hub of the trade in Maharashtra, was ₹850/quintal on Friday. The prices had dropped to ₹600/quintal last month, because of a bumper early kharif crop, which has a shorter shelf life.


"Against the cost of production of ₹1,000/quintal to ₹1,200/quintal, the farmers are getting far less in the mandis," Balasaheb Misal, former director, Manmard (Maharashtra)

mandi board and an onion farmer, told FE.

The estimated production of onion during the 2022-23 crop year (July-June) is around 31.8 million tonne (mt) against 31.7 mt reported in the previous year.

The output of onion was 26.64 mt in 2020-21. To deal with depressed prices, the government had directed the farmers' cooperative Nafed and the NCCF to immediately intervene in the market, through purchase of

onion from the farmers. So far, Nafed has purchased more than 4,000 tonne of onion from farmers in Maharashtra at an average price of ₹900/quintal.

The consumer affairs ministry has also directed Nafed to procure onions from the farmers in Bhavnagar (Mahua), Gondal and Porbandar districts of Gujarat. Currently, the average potato price is ₹650-700/quintal, while ₹1,400-1,600/quintal prevailed a year back. The average cost of production for farmers ranges between ₹800-900/quintal.

"Expectation of bumper crops has pulled down the prices drastically and prices are unlikely to rise in the next couple of months," Vaibhav Sharma, a potato farmer from Agra, the hub of the trade, said. Currently, harvested potatoes are being stored in cold storages, which will meet the domestic demand till October.

Inflation in potatoes declined to 5.43% in January 2023 from 10.05% in December 2022. Inflation rate is expected to decline further in coming months.

The country's potato output in the 2021-22 crop year (July-June) has declined to 53.6 mt from a record output of 56.1 mt in 2020-21.

Version 3 portal for corporate filings faces technical glitches

COMPANIES CONTINUE TO face technical challenges in using the ministry of corporate affairs' (MCA) upgraded Version 3 portal for corporate filings, despite the government's efforts to address such problems.

According to sources, industry associations may seek physical filings of more forms until the portal is fully functional. As of now, such a special dispensation for filing in physical mode has been given for eight forms.

The sources said that the improvement on the portal has been very slow and most issues remain unresolved, even though a high-level panel is understood to be reviewing the issue.

A number of users have also taken to social media and have



submitted their complaints to the specially set-up help desk of the MCA. Sumit Maheshwari, partner, Ashok Maheshwari & Associates, a chartered accountant firm, said, "Subsequent to the transition, a lot of teething issues are being encountered by the stakeholders across India, causing delays in filings of various forms. While the filings are delayed, the failure to generate OTPs to create a log-in and conduct KYC's, especially for over-

seas and foreign directors, has been difficult. Forms flash multiple errors as the website is undeveloped and under the correction phase."

Ankit Singh, head corporate affairs & compliances, Corporate Professionals, said the ministry should relax additional fees for all filings during the January-March quarter. "The V3 of the MCA portal is definitely putting up lot of challenges for both professionals and India Inc. While the MCA appears to be seriously looking into the issues, I think a lot more is required," he said.

Users are understood to be facing several glitches such as those relating to filing incorporation forms even after approval of name (Spice Part A) and registering digital signatures of directors, due to which forms are not being filed.

Bengal govt staff observe strike, demand DA hike

EMPLOYEES PICKETED BEFORE the gates of various West Bengal government offices and educational institutions demanding a hike in Dearness Allowance (DA) as part of a day-long strike on Friday.

Following a strike call by 18 organisations of state government employees, protestors demonstrated in front of office buildings such as Writers Buildings, Bikash Bhavan, Khadya Bhavan, Swastha Bhavan and Kolkata Municipal Corporation in the city.

Similar scenes were witnessed in offices in various district headquarters, blocks, and municipal and panchayat areas.

However, the state government, which has warned of action against absentees, claimed in the evening said that strike evoked no impact on the functioning of the administration as over 90 per cent of attendance was registered.

There was 99 per cent attendance at several departments housed in state secretariat Nabanna and the New Secretariat Building, a senior official said.

The state government in a statement said, "Action will be initiated against employees who have willfully absented themselves today from work". It said that "most of the absentees were covered under different relaxations provided in the state government circular issued on March 9, 2023," it said. The state government has also asked all heads of departments to send a list of those employees who did not attend office to the chief secretary by 5 PM.

A protestor, belonging to the CPI(M)'s employees wing, said

outside the Kolkata Municipal Corporation building that "instead of issuing one notice after another, the government should work towards hiking the DA of state government employees and bring it at par with other states and the Centre.

In Medinipur College in Paschim Medinipur district and North Bengal University at Siliguri and several other places, the agitators forcibly tried to stop the students and employees from entering.

This led to an altercation and exchange of fisticuffs between the supporters of the ruling party and the agitators.

Members of the Jadavpur University Teachers Association (JUTA) observed a half-day cease work in support of the strike call.

All major opposition parties - CPI(M), Congress and BJP - are supporting the strike while the ruling TMC has accused them of disrupting the work culture in the name of agitation.

Senior TMC leader Abhishek Banerjee said those who are "trying to blackmail" the financially starved state administration should be ashamed of themselves. The Mamata Banerjee administration had said no leave will be allowed on March 10 and the absence will be treated as a break in service.

According to an order issued by the state Finance department on Thursday, all state government offices including those provided with grants-in-aid by the state such as educational institutions shall remain open on March 10 and all employees will report for duty on that day. However, no action will be taken against employees who had been on child care leave, maternity leave, medical leave and earned leave sanctioned before March 9, according to the order.
